What is a high school equivalency (HSE) diploma and what can I do with it?

An HSE diploma is an alternative pathway to graduation (formerly known as the GED®). It will give you greater opportunities for life after graduation including college and career training programs. If you already have a job, an HSE diploma will expand your career options and your earnings!

What are Referral Centers?

Referral Centers are your one stop for all of your education related questions. We can help you enroll in free HSE programs, and/or explore high school alternatives. We can also provide referral to various support services such as counseling, career training, and substance abuse treatment.

What is Pathways to Graduation (P2G)?

P2G is a free District 79 program that prepares students aged 18 -21 years old to take the TASC™ exam (formerly known as the GED® test), earn your HSE diploma, and advance to college and career opportunities.

Traditional high school didn't work for me. How is P2G different?

At P2G, we provide students with more than classroom instruction. P2G teachers have classes in very diverse settings such as hospitals, non-profits, community centers and high school buildings. Our counselors will help you build the skills you need to succeed in college and the workplace. College and Career Coaches will help you plan for the future. Our Workforce Development program offers professional training and paid internship opportunities.

I'm over 21. How can I earn my HSE diploma?

Find the Referral Center nearest you to register. After meeting with an experienced Guidance Counselor or Social Worker and taking a placement test, we'll help you register at one of the 65 sites across the 5 boroughs.



**ATTEND AND
DO THE WORK**

Most classes meet in the morning. You'll have to complete a personal statement, résumé, cover letter, and academic project. You will also have to complete your Individualized Learning Plan. It will take at least 6 weeks, but it could take longer depending on your placement test and how often you attend class. The more you go to class, the faster you will earn your HSE Diploma!



TAKE THE TEST

In January 2014, the New York State Education Department replaced the GED® test with the TASC™. The TASC™ is challenging, but P2G teachers and staff will prepare you to pass it. The exam has 5 sections and is 7 hours long. While you prepare to pass the TASC™ and earn your HSE diploma, the College and Career Resource Center will help you plan your next steps.
